

IATP Asbestos Awareness Course

The content of this course is designed to provide anyone whose work could foreseeably expose them to asbestos with sufficient knowledge to avoid putting themselves or others at risk, in line with regulatory requirements laid out in Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Identify the properties of asbestos and outline the history of its use
2. Outline the health effects of asbestos
3. Outline the types, uses and likely occurrence of asbestos and asbestos containing materials (ACMs) in buildings and plant
4. Identify the main statutory provisions that relate to asbestos
5. Know the correct procedures to follow in an emergency
6. Know how to avoid the risks of asbestos

A question and answer session will be held at the end of each module to ensure each learner has reached the necessary level of understanding.

The course is delivered over MS Teams and includes an end of course assessment (Pass mark 80%).
